FEAST OF THE SACRED HEART

The Friday following the Feast of "Corpus Christi" is obviously the best occasion to celebrate the Feast of the Sacred Heart of Christ, because it is the great symbol of the extraordinary love of God for us creatures, as is Holy Communion itself which we celebrate today. So next Friday, 19th June, we'll do this in order to honour the revelation by Christ of this symbol of His Heart to the French nun, St. Margaret Mary Alacoque as a sign of His Love. He tells us of God's Love for us, a love which is ignored by most people, even many Catholics. So this is what the Feast is all about. It is because of this Love that we are created with a hope of an eternal life with God which we will receive if we die faithful to God. We can only thank God by our recognition of this truth on an occasion like this. There is nothing more we can do that God would require of us. On this one day we can do something in a real way by honouring Christ at this evening Mass, cold though the weather is makes it more worthwhile. On Friday night we'll start with a Consecration ceremony at 7.30pm. Then at about 8.00pm the Mass of the Feast will be celebrated by Fr. John GOULDING who has come before. Father Goulding will be hearing Confessions from 7.00pm. The Choir will sing at the Mass. There'll be hot tea/coffee in the Hall afterwards with Father Goulding (just keep your distance)!

Come to honour Christ because of what He has done for us!

Response/ The Lord's kindness is everlasting to those who fear Him!

Gospel Acclamation/ Alleluia, Alleluia! Take my yoke upon you; learn from me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart. Alleluia!

Comm. Antn Thus says the Lord: Let whoever is thirsty come to Me and drink. Streams of living water will flow from within the one who believes in Me!

Gospel Acclamation: Alleluia, Alleluia! I am the Living Bread from Heaven, says the Lord; whoever eats this Bread will live forever. Alleluia!

Communion Antn: Whoever eats my Flesh and drinks my Blood

Remains in Me and I in him, says the Lord!
