All young people **18years up to age about 35** are encouraged to come and experience some Faith & Virtue formation and afterwards some companionship when they can speak to Father informally over tea & coffee and pizza. The time is in the evening and the day's activities are over. That will be from **7.00pm till 8.30pm**!
