BLESSED PETER TO ROT

Blessed Peter To Rot is a person you may never have heard of, even though his Feast Day was celebrated last Tuesday. He was Beatified by Pope JohnPaul II on the 17 January 1995 on his visit to Papua NewGuinea that year. Peter was a NewGuinean who had been put to death by the Japanese at the end of World War II during their occupation of Papua during the War. He was born in Rakunai near Rabaul in 1912. His parents were both converts to Catholicism from paganism, and he was the third of six children. When the Japanese invaded Papua in March of 1942, they imprisoned all the priests and Peter took over the running of the Parish because he was the only catechist left free by the Japanese. He taught the people and did Baptisms. The Japanese arrested him at Christmas of 1944 because he would not stop preaching the Gospel and telling the people about the sanctity of marriage. In July of 1945 he was tortured and put to death on 7th July. He was a remarkable man, and we shall tell his whole story next week!
