Treated as the prophets

As part of his sermon, Jesus announces, 'Happy are you when people hate you, drive you out, abuse you, denounce your name as criminal, on account of the Son of Man... 

The Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick

The Anointing of the Sick is a sacrament of healing that comforts and heals, physically and/or spiritually, people who are seriously ill and those in danger of death. The ritual consists of prayers, scripture message and anointing the forehead and palms of

the sick with the Oil for the Sick by a presbyter.

The Gospel of St. Mark (6:12-13) gives us an indication of this sacrament of the sick when he tells us that the apostles, going forth, "preached those men should repent, and they cast out many devils, and anointed with oil many sick people, and healed them." Likewise, the letter of St. James clearly describes the sacrament as he wrote:

Is anyone among you sick? Let him bring in the presbyters [priests] of the Church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord. And the prayer of faith will save the sick man, and the Lord will raise him up, and if he be in sins, they shall be forgiven him (James 5:14-15). This sacrament of Anointing of the Sick, along with the Sacrament of Penance is relevant this time of pandemic as there are many who got sick physically and spiritually who long for healing. It is also an important invitation to parishioners to pray, care for the sick and elderly members of the community. And with St. James' encouragement, may I invite members of our parish, if there are sick members of our community needing the Sacrament of Anointing and Penance, or sacrament of communion, kindly inform the parish office.


