

### **Ascension: Mystery of Presence**

What do we mean when we profess the article of faith that

Jesus ascended into heaven and now seated at the right hand of the Father? There seems to be a notion that when Jesus ascended, he has gone afar from this world, went beyond the cosmos and will be back on his second coming at the end of times. This notion may have been based on the ascension account (Lk 24,51; Mk 17,19) where it is written that the disciples saw Jesus was being taken up to heaven and then not anymore physically present. But the reaction of the disciples is puzzling. Unlike during the crucifixion and death, they lamented for the loss, after the ascension they were joyful and confident of Jesus' presence with them (cf. Lk,24,51-53 and Mk 16,20). The ascension event was indeed an unusual departure. Jesus bade them farewell and blessed them, but in reality, He did not leave and abandon them.

Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI beautifully explained this mystery in his book Jesus of Nazareth as he wrote, "the departing of Jesus does not make his way to some distant star. He enters into communion of power and life with the living God, into God's dominion over space. Hence, he has not 'gone away', but now and forever by God's own power he is present with us and for us." (Jesus of Nazareth: Holy Week, p. 283). We then understand that the Ascension is a mystery of presence not of absence or abandonment. The Ascension is a transition from incarnated presence to presence in power and spirit. His presence in power is evident in the healing stories of the disciples in the Acts of the apostles (e.g. Act 3,1; 4,22;5,12-16,207-12). His assuring presence in spirit has been the source of joy and confidence of the disciples as they went to different places proclaiming the story about Jesus. Consequently, unrestricted by time and space, Jesus' presence has been simultaneously experienced by the disciples in different instances, in different places and in different times.


