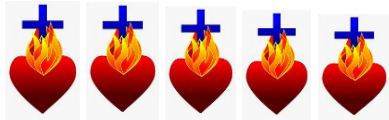


## Parish Notices

**The MOST HOLY TRINITY**

**12th June 2022**



**From Fr Flor's desk**

**The Holy Trinity**

God is all-powerful, all-knowing, omnipresent and a Trinity. While the other attributes of God are easily accepted, the doctrine of the Trinity has had controversies in the past as well as at present. This is a revealed truth which remains a mystery (Mt 28,19; also cf. Jn 14,16; 15,28; 2 Cor 13,14).

We are humbled by the limit of our rationality to grasp the whole truth. But with our spirit-inspired capacity of understanding this reality, we can be full of wonder. The Trinitarian Godhead is unique and beautiful. This is a monotheistic belief in God, but of three distinct persons: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. This means that God is relational in Himself. It is ultimately of love relation that unites. The understanding of God as Trinity is consistent to the image of God as love (1 John 4,8). As love is defined as total self-giving to the other, in the Trinitarian Godhead, there is the other as object of love. Each distinct person shares the totality of their own being in pure love and so completely united.

Celebrating the feast of the Holy Trinity is an opportunity for us to regenerate our sense of wonder of this beautiful image of God as Trinity and Love. It is always joyful and meaningful to believe in a God who Himself exemplify to us the power of relational love. It is also most affirming to us as we acknowledge that creation and redemption are free overflow of God's love. Likewise, we are reminded of our vocation to unite ourselves to God in love (cf. Jn 17, 21-23). Thankfully, obedience to Jesus' commandment (Jn 13,35), our acts of charity and our expressions of true love towards others are instances where we have realised our oneness with God.

As we celebrate this feast we pray with Jesus: that all may be one. (Jn 17,21)

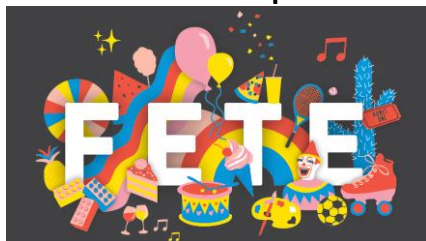

## HISTORICAL CONTEXT

### The Nicene Creed

*The definitive statement of Christian belief is contained within the Nicene Creed that is proclaimed by the community in the Mass. It was developed by the Council of Nicea, held in 325, in response to a variety of teachings (some declared to be heresy) that were circulating at the time and the creed was further revised in 381. The creed declares that Jesus is 'God from God, light from light, true God from true God ... of one being with the Father' and that the Holy Spirit 'proceeds from the Father and the Son'. All of these statements seek to define the oneness of the Trinitarian God.*
