

Covenant Relationship

In the parable of the Prodigal Son in today's gospel reading (Lk 15,1-32), both sons betray the juridical mentality of contractors in their dealings with their father. For example, when the prodigal son becomes aware of his misdeed, he does not for one moment imagine that his father could forgive him and take him back as a loved son. His approach to his problem is entirely legalistic. He devises a plan that will enable him to earn a decent living as his father's employee. His older brother is equally legalistic minded in his approach. He talks to his father in contractual terms. "I slaved for you, without ever disobeying your orders...", "You've never given me a goat..." This is an entirely contractual approach employer-employee. The father sweeps it aside with one shattering revelation, "All I have is yours." Jesus was indirectly attacking the juridical approach of the Pharisees (represented by the elder and partly the young son). Family relationships are not based on a **contract**, he says implicitly but on a **covenant**. A family is not a courtroom, and the head of the family is not a judge but a father. The whole purpose of this parable of Jesus is to emphasise the basic idea: God is a loving Father.

How many of us still understand their relationship with God in terms of a contract rather than a covenant? The parable is a revelation that God is our Father, the most loving Father one can possibly imagine. His mercy and love have no bounds, no limits, because it is his very being. "God is love", John tells us repeatedly (cf. 1 Jn 4,8). Once, we believe this, our lives are changed forever. (adapted from Hearts Burning by Nil Guillemette)


