From Fr Marcus's desk The Eucharist is the "source and summit of the Christian life." The other Sacraments, and indeed all ecclesiastical ministries and works of the apostolate, are bound up with the Eucharist and are oriented toward it. For the blessed Eucharist is contained the whole spiritual good of the Church, namely Christ himself, our Pasch. (Catechism of the Catholic Church # 1324)

This truth of the teaching of our faith reminds us of who we are as a Church or Family and points towards our relationship with Our Lord. The Holy Catholic Church is identified by ourselves and also by our brothers and sisters of other Christian churches. The Gospel of this Sunday speaks to us not be "fools" but for our "eyes to be opened" every time we attend the Holy Sacrifice of the Eucharist. The two disciples who were traveling with the Lord recognised Jesus when he said the blessing and broke the bread in front of them. It was great for the two disciples to witness this Holy Mass with the Lord and for them to leave that room and share what they have encountered to the other followers.

Sadly, many Catholics still live with the doubt that our Lord Jesus is not really present in the consecrated bread and wine. It can be in the complete refusal of the catholic and abandoning the faith in the Eucharist and to the common "I won't go to Sunday Mass because I have important things to do!" Father John Flander shared in one of his blogs reflecting on the doubt that we show towards the Eucharist; in this case a doubt from a priest who is been graced with the gift to consecrate the bread and wine. Fr Flander writes: "Occasionally, sometimes to shore up the faith of people who doubted his Real Presence, Our Lord has done a miracle to make clear that the Eucharist is truly his Body and Blood. In recent decades some of these miracles have been subjected to scientific examinations, which have resulted in extraordinary findings. Such is the case with the miracles of Buenos Aires in 1996, Poland in 2008, and even the eighth century miracle of Lanciano.

I am sure we would love to experience this great sign within our own humble Sacred Parish of Mt Druitt South! But we must have Faith and see with our eyes of faith that the Lord is present in the Tabernacle and when with my unworthy self will bless our gift of the bread and wine for our Mass of this third Sunday. I personally thank our parishioners and friends for attending our last Sunday's (Divine Mercy Sunday 2023) adoration and benediction. It brings to me the realization that we all need that time with our Lord and we will continue with this Holy Hour. May the Lord bless us all in this Sunday and to look towards the Lord and trust in him as we face our daily busy routines in the coming week. As the late Pope Benedict XVI wrote in his book "The heart of the Christian life", he encourages parents to be with their children at Mass: "You will see that time is not LOST, RATHER, it is the very thing that can keep your family united and centred."
