# From Deacon Rod's desk ......

Reading I: 2 Kings 4:8-11, 14-16a

The provision of hospitality by the Shunammite woman for the prophet Elisha is one of the more engaging episodes of the Old Testament. Clearly it was chosen because it illustrates the saying in the gospel: "He who receives a prophet because he is a prophet shall receive a prophet's reward." Her kindness to receiving Elisha is repaid with the blessing of a child.

To be a holy man of God in the Old Testament does not signalize mystical achievement but means to be the bearer of God's word—a word that is "truth," that is, not that it passes the test of doctrinal orthodoxy, but that it effects what it says on the plane of history. Similarly, Elisha is a holy man of God, not because of the achievements of his piety, but because he, like his predecessor, Elijah was entrusted to proclaim to his generation the effective word of Yhwh.

In the Gospel, Jesus reminds his followers that discipleship means putting God above any other attachments, even the bonds of family. A challenge indeed. Even our parents may become our idols. To be a disciple of Jesus, is to put Jesus first at all times — in the centre of all our daily activities with the knowledge that we are accompanied and led by Him. These are not easy words to read, and not easy things to do. This week, let us contemplate more deeply how we are following Jesus' words to follow His footsteps.


