

From Fr Marcus's desk

"In the Name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit...AMEN."

This is the common holy gesture and uttered words that we as Catholics always perform. We make the sign of the cross in every aspect of our lives: from the highest participation in the Holy Sacrifice of the Eucharist and to most humble and everyday moments, such as saying grace before having a meal. The Sign of the Cross is our profound *Identity* as Catholics that we must always not hesitate to perform the holy gesture. It reminds us all about the great sacrifice and love that Christ expressed on the Cross. He did the will of His Father and offer us the gift of the Holy Spirit. By saying the Sign of the Cross, we also say with great reverence the name of the *Most Holy Trinity*.

The relationship of the Most Holy Trinity - three *Persons but One God* brings us in union with the universal Church and reflects strongly our relationship with God and with each other. The Doctrine of this *Mystery of Faith* has been taught and guarded with great diligence from the earliest days of the Christian faith. Many *false* teachers tried their best to sway the faithful from the truth of the Divine Nature of God. The Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches us the faithful: *"The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of Christian faith and life. It is the mystery of God in himself. It is therefore the source of all the other mysteries of faith, the light that enlightens them. It is the most fundamental and essential teaching in the "hierarchy of the truths of faith".*



So let this Sunday of the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity be a great renewal for us all. We can acknowledge that our mere human understanding can never match the Lord, but it is by the *Mystery of our Faith* that we love the Lord, *God of Three Persons*. St John Marie Vianney (priest) encourages us to make the sign of the cross and saying the Name of the Trinity because "the sign of the cross is the most effective weapon against the devil."
