

From Deacon Rod's desk

"Come to me, all you who labour and are overburdened and I will give you rest. Shoulder my yoke and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls." (Mt. 11: 28-29)

This passage is taken from the gospel reading for this weekend. It is an incredibly comforting and reassuring passage. It invites us to face up to the problems and difficulties of life, to the burdens that we have to carry and to the fact that at times we have to search for meaning. It also invites us to look at our image of our God. This is so very important because I think too often we keep God at a distance and we don't have a real living relationship with him. In this passage we have a wonderful description of God's attitude to us. He invites us to come to him and he tells us that he is gentle and humble of heart. He wants us to have a relationship with him and he wants us to ask for his help in a matter how small or how big our area of need is at this moment.

What really strikes me about this passage is that while I might still have my burdens in life, I am not alone. The Lord is my companion and in him I am able to find new strength and new attitudes. This is one of the things that Saint Paul emphasized so often. We do have God on our side and we know that we will get through everything that life tosses at us because our God is not only on our side, but he is with us every moment.

The final point that I would like to make is the invitation of Jesus to learn from him. To be a Christian is to have Jesus as our teacher. He is our God who wants to teach us how to achieve our potential; he is our God who is the expert on us and knows exactly how we need to live. But, of course, we have to do our part. We present ourselves as students, whether it is in prayer or in our study. We are always students, in making the Bible part of our lives and in our understanding of our faith through the teachings of the Church.

We need to accept that God really does want to be part of our lives.
