

From Fr Marcus's desk Forgiveness comes from God.

In the blink of an eye a beautiful moment turned into the worst moment of my life," she said between tears. "I will never forget being there and feeling helpless, as much as I tried to help I couldn't. "I struggled so much to forgive myself let alone to forgive the driver." "But by forgiveness and hope helped me through it. (Mabelle Kassas-survivor of the tragedy crash at Oatlands three years ago)

We were all shocked when this happened, and in astonishment that the mother, Mrs Leila Abdulla and her husband Mr David Abdulla, publicly forgave the young drunk driver. This great act of forgiveness has helped their family members through this tragedy. Their story eventually made it to the Vatican where they shared their experience with Pope Francis. We all have our own "tragedies" that have hurt us to the core of our hearts. It is very normal reaction for us to feel resentment, rage and revenge towards those who have hurt us.

Jesus today tells St. Peter to forgive others and like St Peter, we are not always ready to accept this. It is challenging but in order to forgive, we need God to help us: we need faith, humility and a great effort on our part to understand forgiveness. Mabelle, who is a young person, learnt this in the hardest way but she tells Australia and the world that forgiveness and hope helped her profoundly. Let us turn to God to help us to forgive because: "the Lord is kind and merciful, slow to anger, but rich in compassion."
