From Fr Marcus' Desk

The parable of the Wedding Banquet that we proclaim in the Gospel this weekend (Matt 22:1-14) is the Matthean version of a parable that appears in rather different forms in the early tradition (cf. Luke 14:15-24). Matthew has made the parable a kind of allegory of salvation history. The wedding feast represents the fullness of salvation, the bridegroom the Son of God (Jesus). The servants sent one after the other to issue invitations, represent firstly, the prophets sent to Israel in the Old Testament era.

When again Israel fails to respond, they are told to invite those 'on the crossroads' – the Gentiles. The final scene where the king notices a guest not wearing a wedding garment and orders him to be cast out, brings the allegory to a close. It evokes the last judgment, when the mixture of good and bad in the Christian community will be sorted out.

Matthew presents the parable in this form to help his community understand and come to terms with unexpected and troubling things that had occurred: the 'No' of the bulk of Israel to the message of the Gospel, the existence of bad, as well as good, in the community of the Church. Having Jesus tell the parable in this way shows that all had been foreseen and foretold by him and therefore should not cause too great dismay or loss of faith.
