

## From Deacon Rod's Desk .....

I am full of gratitude that I have been a delegate together with Ben and Martha Bowmann from our Sacred Heart Parish to represent the Parish in our first Diocesan Synod last weekend. It has been two and half long days in which around 200 delegates from all the diocese of Parramatta, met to pray, listen and vote on the 6 themes presented to us. The six themes came from the summary of all the submissions and consultations that happened around the diocese.

The Synod writing group synthesised submissions under the following six themes: 1. An inclusive and welcoming Church.

- 2. A humble and healing Church.
- 3. A listening Church.
- 4. A Church renewed in spirit and prayer.
- 5. A Church that reaches to the margins.
- 6. A Church walking together.

We shared how the Holy Spirit was speaking to us from the Word of God and the proposed resolutions. We fed back to the round table of eight delegates what we have heard and afterwards, there were opportunities for the delegates to share their voices from the floor. It was then, that we voted for the resolutions under each of the six themes – 25 resolutions in total.

"The Diocesan journey of synodality is the source of renewal for us. The time has come for us to take seriously our baptismal mission, agency, and discipleship." Bishop Vincent Long reminded us in his opening welcoming words. This is a unique time were our diocese and our parish is renewed to continue to love and serve others. It is a time, when we are alert to the signs of the times, desire to be humble and ask for forgiveness. A synodal Church welcomes and embraces all and manages the tensions without being crushed by them. Deacon Rod.
