## From Deacon Rod's desk ...... More than Ashes.

While ashes upon our foreheads serve as a stark reminder of our mortality, they symbolise much more. They mark the beginning of Lent, a 40-day journey towards Easter, but more importantly, they invite us to embark on a deep cleaning and 'pruning' of the soul.

Lent is like spring cleaning prompting us to dust off the cobwebs within. It's a time to shed old habits, confront our shadows, and cultivate a deeper connection with ourselves and our higher purpose. This isn't just about giving up chocolate or social media; it's about intentionally evaluating our thoughts, words, and actions. Where do we harbour negativity? What judgments cloud our perception?
