From Fr Marcus' desk Let us enter "Holy Week."

In 2015 at our seminary, Pacific Regional Seminary (PRS) in Suva, Fiji, our community was blessed with the presence of the Father Superior of the Congregation of the Sacred Hearts (Jesus and Mary). The religious order is commonly known as the 'Picpus' Fathers. This is the community in which St. Fr Damien of Molokai was a professed member. On Palm Sunday that year his homily was focused on the upcoming Holy Week. I will never forget his simple outline of the Holy Week which my other brothers of PRS and I will love to share with you. He emphasized the symbols of the Liturgies that we are preparing for:

Palm Sunday: -Symbol: Palm branch Welcome the Lord as the King For the **Chrism Mass**: - Symbols: The Holy Oils of Chrism, Catechumen & Sick. It is also a special time for us, your servants when all the priests will renew their vows.

Holy Triduum:

Holy Thursday (Maundy Thursday) Symbols- The Altar (Christ gifted us the Sacrament of the Eucharist and the Holy Priesthood; Washing of the feet reminds us of being servants.

Good Friday-Focus on the Cross on which "Hung our Salvation."

Easter Vigil-The Paschal Candle (Christ is our Light) and water of our Baptism. (New members of the Church are welcomed.)

The Triduum concludes:

Resurrection Sunday: - Symbol: The Empty Tomb.

This is a simple outline that can guide us through the solemn Liturgies of this week. Let us reflect and journey together in faith.
