

From Deacon Rod's desk Be Fruitful and Multiply

The first command God gave to human beings was "be fruitful and multiply" (<u>Gen.1:28</u>). In the <u>Gospel</u> Reading, there is a kind of reiteration of this command. At any rate, the text describes the bad things that happen to people who are not fruitful.

In Genesis, the fruitfulness has to do with reproduction. It comes from union between a man and a woman, and it multiplies God's image in the production of children. The fruitfulness at issue in the <u>Gospel</u> comes from connection too, but connection with Christ. It comes when Christ is in you, and you are in him. Love unites you and your beloved without either one of you losing your identity. The union of love is not a fusing; it is a mutual indwelling. In the <u>Gospel</u> Reading, Christ says that he always remains in his own. So, if we yield to Christ in love, we have what is needed for the mutual indwelling of love. We are our beloved's, and he is ours. (<u>Song of</u> <u>Songs 6:3</u>) There is joy in this love, because Christ is so much with us that he is in each one of us. There is peace, too, because there is rest for the heart in having my beloved with me.

Our sins and the storms of life retain their power to afflict us. But we can more easily put up with things, even our own troublesome self, if our beloved is ours and we are his. In that mutual indwelling, then, there is love, joy, peace, patience and longsuffering. But these very things are fruits of the Holy Spirit. When they grow in us, we are bearing fruit.

Hence, If I have the fruits of the Holy Spirit in me, I will multiply God's image in others too. And so, by remaining in Christ, I am doing what will make me be fruitful and multiply.
