

From Fr Marcus' Desk......

The French Revolution of 1789 and the Russian Revolution of 1917 are two classic examples of many past and present upheavals that sought dramatic change in all aspects of those societies. The French Revolution was aiming for the downfall of the aristocracy which they also see the Catholic Church as part of it. For Russia, the people wanted a socialist society that all people will share goods. Alas, great intentions, but they created more hostility and despair in which the revolutions only resulted in the original but more worse societies. The Novel "Animal Farm" (1945) by George Orwell in his political satire shows that the seek of power and change will only result in greed and comfort with it. In the novel, the pigs who stood for change in the farm became more cruel and more living like dictators. Jesus in the Gospel of this Sunday, says to us to *love our enemies;* which it can be possible if we firstly *change our own hearts first.* The revolutions that occurred, there was no change of hearts from within, but to break hearts of many.

Our readings of today is very challenging to us all because enemies make us weary, fearful, resentment and the worse...to hate. Jesus strikes us with his teaching about *loving* and *not judging* others. Of course, it is almost impossible to follow this, but it come from firstly *change our own hearts first*. David had every reason to kill King Saul, but he with clear heart despite his followers' objection, not to harm God's *anointed one*. For David he stands for right and justice. The Second reading speaks to us about the resurrection from the second Adam which is Jesus. The First Adam was the cause of our downfall but with God's grace we have been gifted and given another holy opportunity with the Lord. So rightly the Psalm says, *The Lord is kind and Merciful*. Let's pray for the conversion of our own hearts first in order to understand clearly what Jesus is saying to us today.
