From Fr Taliai's Desk......

Luke 13: 1-9 Theme:

"Give me time to dig round it"

The term μετάνοια (metanoia) is predominantly found in the New Testament, signifying a significant transformation of both mind and heart. This transformation is often linked to the act of turning away from sin and redirecting oneself towards God. It encompasses an acknowledgment of one's misdeeds, genuine remorse, and a dedication to altering one's conduct in accordance with divine will. This notion is fundamental to the Christian doctrine of salvation and is frequently associated with faith and conversion. Jesus, allow these unfortunate events to awaken you from your state of complacency. Let these occurrences serve as a challenge for you to engage in repentance. May they act as a clarion call, urging individuals to reflect on their lives to avoid facing a far graver calamity during the time of God's judgment, which is inevitable.

This leads us to today's Lenten symbol: the unproductive fig tree. The parable of the unproductive fig tree serves as a cautionary tale, reminding us that we cannot indefinitely evade μετάνοια (metanoia). A time of accountability will eventually arrive. The vineyard owner possesses a fig tree that has not borne fruit for three consecutive years. The owner commands that it be cut down, questioning its purpose for occupying space. However, the gardener interjects, "Sir, allow it one more year. Permit me to cultivate the soil around it and fertilize it." There is an opportunity for repentance, yet it cannot be delayed indefinitely.
