From Fr Marcus' desk.....

In Deuteronomy 30:10-14, Moses urges the people to obey God's commandments with heart and soul. He reminds them that God's law is not distant or hidden. It is already within them, ready to be lived out. This moment comes near the end of Moses' speeches before the people enter the Promised Land. He is calling them to recommit to the covenant.

Psalm 69 is a cry from someone suffering deeply. The speaker pleads with God to answer quickly. Even in distress, there is trust that God hears the poor and saves those in need. This psalm shows the raw honesty of prayer and the hope that God will bring justice.

Psalm 19, the alternate responsorial psalm, praises God's law as life-giving. It speaks of the law as perfect, wise, joyful, and pure. These verses show a deep love for God's instructions and describe them as more precious than gold or honey.

Colossians 1:15-20 is a hymn about Christ's role in creation and redemption. He is the visible image of God, the firstborn of all creation, and the head of the Church. Through His death, He brings peace and unity to all things in heaven and on earth.

The Letter to the Colossians focuses on Christ's supremacy and the new life He brings. This passage lifts our eyes to the cosmic work of Jesus. On the 15th Sunday in Ordinary Time Year C, we are invited to see Jesus not just as teacher or healer, but as the one who holds all creation together.

Luke 10:25-37 tells the story of the Good Samaritan. When a scholar asks how to inherit eternal life, Jesus answers with a story. A man is attacked and left for dead. Religious leaders pass by. A Samaritan, seen as an outsider, is the one who shows mercy and care.

This story fits Luke's focus on compassion, outsiders, and real love in action. On this 15th Sunday in Ordinary Time Year C, Jesus teaches that loving your neighbour has no boundaries. Mercy matters more than status or religious role.
