From Deacon Rod's desk.....

Trusting in God's Promise — 19th Sunday in Ordinary Time (Year C)

This Sunday's readings invite us into a deeper reflection on faith, trust, and readiness. The 19th Sunday in Ordinary Time (Year C) centres on the quiet strength of belief and the call to live with hearts open to God's promises.

First Reading: Wisdom 18:6–9 The Book of Wisdom recalls the night of the Passover, when the Israelites trusted in God's word and were delivered from oppression. Their faith was not passive—it was active, expressed through obedience and hope. This passage reminds us that God's promises are fulfilled in His time, and our role is to remain faithful even when the outcome is unseen.

Second Reading: Hebrews 11:1–2, 8–19 Hebrews offers a powerful meditation on faith as "the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen." Abraham's journey becomes the model: he left his homeland, trusted in God's covenant, and believed in the impossible—that he would become the father of many nations. His story challenges us to trust God beyond our own understanding and to walk forward even when the path is unclear.

Gospel: Luke 12:32–48 Jesus urges His disciples to be vigilant and prepared, like servants awaiting their master's return. "Where your treasure is, there your heart will be also." This Gospel calls us to examine our priorities and live with spiritual alertness. Faith is not just belief—it's readiness, generosity, and stewardship.

Living the Word

This Sunday, we're reminded that faith is a journey, not a destination. Like Abraham, we are called to trust, to act, and to wait with hope. May we live as people of promise—watchful, generous, and grounded in the assurance that God is faithful.
