From Fr Taliai's desk......

In today's Gospel Luke describes Jesus' journey with his disciples to Jerusalem. That pilgrimage is not just about a journey from Galilee in the North to Jerusalem in the South. It is also an inner journey. Jesus is taking the opportunity to teach his disciples about life in God's kingdom. And there is an urgency about Jesus' teaching. So, the questioner in today's gospel is asking Jesus for a response. Jesus doesn't answer the question directly; he refuses to speculate on a matter that is best left to the wisdom and mercy of God. In so many words Jesus seems to be saying, "All you need to concern yourself about is your own salvation".

He does this by using the image of a door - in fact the image of two doors. Firstly, that of the narrow door, and then that of the locked door. One door is difficult to enter; the other is impossible because it has been locked. So, entry into the kingdom is not a walk in the park. In other words, there is no room for fence-sitters in the kingdom of God. There are no privileged entry-permits to the eternal life which Jesus offers. You are either a player or a spectator; you are an actor in the drama of salvation, or you're a member of the audience.

We are outsiders if:

- the Gospel message has become little more than an amusing and harmless part of the show.
- we have become mere spectators on the journey of faith.
- the practice of our faith vaccinates us against a true change of heart.
- we spend our life talking about the river, fearful of ever taking the plunge.
- we are reluctant to set the world ablaze with our faith.

Strive to enter by the narrow door. Amen
