From Deacon Rod's Desk.....

"As you go, proclaim that the kingdom of heaven is close at hand."

There are moments in life when we sense a call beyond ourselves—an invitation to respond to a need, to step forward, to serve. These moments echo the heart of Jesus' message today. The mission he gives is urgent, not distant or optional. It is *as you go*—in the ordinary movement of life—that we are sent.

Jesus directs his disciples toward the "lost sheep," those on the margins, those overlooked or forgotten. This is not a mission of comfort but of compassion. It demands attentiveness to where people are hurting, excluded, or searching for hope. The kingdom draws near not merely in words, but in acts of mercy, presence, and courage.

In today's Australia, this call is just as pressing. We see the lost sheep in the lonely elderly, in struggling families, in Indigenous communities still seeking justice and recognition, in refugees and migrants trying to find belonging, and in young people wrestling with anxiety and purpose. The mission of the Gospel is not abstract—it is lived in these real encounters.

The urgency of Jesus' words reminds us that the time to respond is now. We do not wait until we feel ready or equipped. Instead, we trust that God works through our willingness. Each small act of care, each listening ear, each step toward the margins makes the kingdom visible.

To proclaim that the kingdom is close at hand is to live as if it truly is—here, now, within reach—whenever we answer the call to love beyond ourselves.
